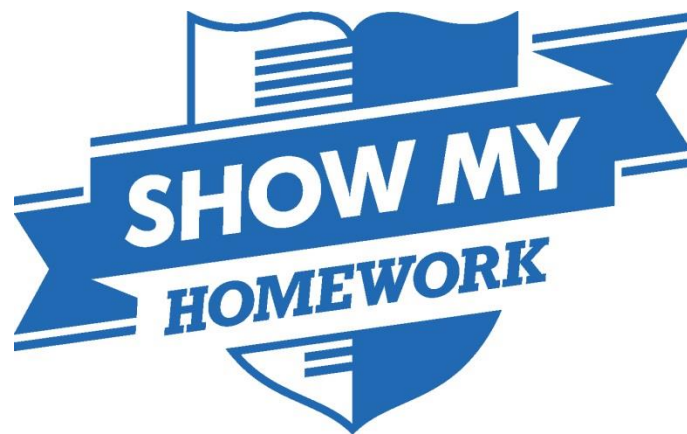

# So what is it?

Show My Homework (SMHW) is a simple, online homework calendar that allows teachers to set homework in advance.

## Create Homework



# How does it work?
